The annual Persoids meteor

The annual Perseids meteor shower runs until Aug. 24 with the peak from Wednesday, Aug. 12 to Thursday, Aug. 13. To view, face the northeast in the constellation of Perseids. The best time to see the meteor shower is between 11 p.m. and dawn.

On Saturday, Aug. 15, look east before sunrise to see the conjuncture of a crescent moon and Venus.

On Friday, Aug. 28 before sunset, Jupiter and Saturn will be close to the moon. If you have a good telescope, you can actually see the rings of Saturn, which is a treat!

This is an excellent month to view the Milky Way – and without freezing. The best time to view our home galaxy this month is after 11 p.m. until dawn.
